- Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or "the University") Regulations
 Governing Promotion Reviews by the Faculty Evaluation Committee ("the
 Committee") are formulated in accordance with Article 7, Paragraph 1,
 Subparagraph 3 of NTU Regulations for the Establishment of the Faculty
 Evaluation Committee to ensure that members of the Committee thoroughly read and check the applications for promotion.
- Article 2 The meeting notice for the Committee's annual promotion review shall stipulate that all members must thoroughly examine the applicants' information. Photocopies of the competent college's review opinion sheet, approval vote tally, and publication review opinion sheet, as included in the promotion recommendation packet, shall be distributed to Committee members for review one week prior to the meeting date.
- Article 3 Prior to the promotion review meeting, documents submitted by applicants for promotion shall be exhibited in a suitable venue for perusal by Committee members who wish to examine the original for further information after having read through the copies.
- Article 4 Ex officio members who are unable to attend a meeting may appoint a nonmember of the same faculty rank to attend on their behalf, and shall notify the Committee beforehand. Non-members acting as proxies shall read all relevant promotion application documents thoroughly as stipulated by the provisions herein.
- Article 5 The Regulations shall be passed by the Committee and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
