- If a full-time faculty member (research fellow) wishes to hold a concurrent position off-campus, they must complete and submit this form seeking permission from National Taiwan University (NTU) if the school where they are teaching part-time has not sent an official letter requesting permission from NTU. This application form is not necessary if the school has already sent an official letter to NTU requesting permission.
- 2. For full-time faculty members teaching part-time off campus, the NTU *Directives Governing Full-Time Faculty Members Engagement in Off-Campus Part-Time Teaching* ("the Directives") shall be in effect.
- 3. Full-time faculty members taking on part-time teaching off-campus shall do so **during daytime** office hours and for no more than four hours per week.
- 4. A faculty member's concurrent position part-time teaching shall not compromise the quality of their job at NTU. They shall continue to meet all NTU basic teaching hour and job requirements. Schools where faculty members intend to teach part-time shall first write a letter to NTU for approval. The basic teaching hour requirements as described in the preceding paragraph shall be calculated as **the number of teaching hours from the semester before** the faculty member in question is to teach off-campus on a part-time basis. If the faculty member fails to meet the basic weekly teaching hour requirements, the average teaching hours of the previous two semesters may apply. However, exceptions to this rule may be made under special circumstances with approval.
- 5. Faculty members **may not** engage in off-campus part-time teaching under any of the following circumstances:
 - (1) The nature of the off-campus course is inherently different from that taught at NTU.
 - (2) The school offering the course is an institution at a level equivalent to or below a junior college.
 - (3) The faculty member in question is a new faculty member who has not met the basic teaching hour requirements for the previous semester.
 - (4) The faculty member is an assistant professor who has been approved for a reduction in or exemption from basic teaching hours within two years upon their appointment.
 - (5) The faculty member failed the most recent evaluation.
 - (6) The faculty member has committed violations stipulated in the NTU *Directives for Handling Violations of Faculty Accreditation Review Regulations and Academic Integrity*, where the review results prohibit the faculty member from teaching part-time.
 - (7) There are other regulations in place prohibiting the faculty member from teaching parttime.
- 6. If NTU and another school have a collaborative relationship or if there is a special need, and the other school hiring the full-time faculty member to teach part-time notifies NTU in writing for prior approval, then the faculty member teaching part-time may not be subject to the regulations stipulated in Article 3 and Article 4, Subparagraphs 1-3 of the Directives.
- 7. The Directives shall apply mutatis mutandis to full-time specialists, contract faculty members appointed with the University Endowment Fund, and visiting faculty members. Except for the stipulations related to NTU's basic teaching hour requirements, the Directives shall apply

		mutatis mutandis to quota-based research fellows and contract research fellows appointed with
		the University Endowment Fund.

		academic research approved by the University. Those who plan to engage in work unrelated to
		their research project may only do so with the prior permission given by the Faculty Evaluation
		Committee of their respective academic program.
